How should we proceed?

- First, we <u>must</u> try to understand the difference between the old man and the new.
- Then, we <u>must</u> <u>discover the equipment</u> that God has provided for us to <u>live</u> like the new!
- Finally, we must learn to walk according to the new.

Two problems:

- 1. The old man doesn't have the will to obey the commandments of God.
 - He has a heart of stone and, sometimes, as hard as flint! (Zechariah 7:12)
- 2. The old man doesn't have the capacity to live according to the will of God.

What about the Soul?

 The spiritual man may <u>lack understanding</u> of certain things, may <u>feel</u> tired or sad, and he may have <u>an urge</u> <u>to control</u> the whole experience.

• He refuses to allow his thoughts, his feelings and his will to lead as he walks with God.

What about the Soul?

- That being said...
- Being a spiritual being <u>does not imply</u> that the soul is under-estimated and eliminated from the experience...

What about the Soul?

- The soul must find its <u>rightful</u> place as a close collaborator of the spirit
 - i.e., bringing all its abilities to the service of the spirit without seeking to be the controlling element in our spiritual walk.
 - We must feel free to <u>fully engage</u> our thinking, our emotions, our creativity, our will, and our decision-making abilities in the spiritual experience!
 - We have gained <u>new spiritual abilities</u>, but we should also feel free and excited to use <u>our natural gifts!</u>



Romans 13:8-10


- 3 Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.




The Carnal Believer
